The shows originated from the North East where Bob was working on a home built in 1921. “The old shutters were broken and rotted and it's really not worth the time and efforts to fix them, so new shutters from J&L/PERMEX Shutters were put on” said Bob.

The Installation went smoothly

The shutters are a Permex synthetic material. They are pre-painted at the factory with a 10-year guarantee, warranty, on the painting itself. They are movable, and have metal reinforcement down through the stiles so that it's a much stronger shutter, and you never have to worry, for the next 10 years, as far as repainting them or fixing them.

J&L/Permex provided the historic-style hardware and hinges. All the screws are stainless steel, so there is no worry about rusting over a period of time. Their shutters are operable and functional. The last thing to do was to put on the shutter dog, which goes down at the bottom, and actually holds the shutter in an open position.

You could just screw the shutters right to the house, but then you'd lose some of the historic value or appeal. You have the old-style hinges. When you want, you can actually use them and close the shutter so that it actually can protect the windows in the case of a bad storm. And these are also made of Permex material, which will not rot, warp, or crack. So they'll last a very long time, and you'll really enjoy them.
